

When Zeus took the shape of a bull and stole Europa, Agenor who was her father ordered his four suns to search for her. He also ordered them not to come back to their birthplace without her.


Thus, Phoenix headed southwards, Cilix northwards, Cadmus wandered around Greece and Thasus, (who according to other versions was the son of Cilix), after having traveled to remote places, reached verdant

Thassos, where he stayed - thus giving his name to the island.




ARCHANGEL MICHAEL'S MONASTERY


SAINT PANTELEIMON MONASTERY


Every year, the church celebrates on the 15th of August with a feast and music.

MIKRO & MEGALO KAZAVITI


One of the most traditional villages that can be found are the Mikro and Megalo Kazaviti. Home to premium local wines, for those who want to explore the areas unique vineyards.

Built on a mountain territory in order to avoid pirate attacks, today they offer warm hospitality, an interesting architectural point of view, alongside with a secluded forestry area and a stone theater lost in time.

During the summertime an Art Festival takes place in Kazaviti, called **Kazavitiana**, offering an amazing summer experience.




RACHONI


Rachoni village is a perfect example of 19th century AD mansions, that were built to avoid sea attacks and is famous for its olive oil, poly-floral honey and walnut spoon preserves.

It provides you with the option of olive- picking excursions, while you can also visit the Olive Oil Museum.

During the first 10 days of August, the Beekeeping Cooperative of Thassos is organizing a Honey Festival, where all honey and local products (sweets, cheese and wine) are free of charge.


SOTIR6\S

PADAGIA


Another picturesque settlement in the northeastern part of the island that preserves its traditional architecture with its slate roofs and wooden balconies.

Today, Theologos preserves many of its traditions and is famous for its gastronomy - especially for its "Goat on a spit", which you can enjoy in one of the traditional taverns.






SKALA SOTIROS

The most characteristic trait of Skala Sotiros would have to be its vast acres of olive trees, extending up to the sea.





DRAGO® CAVE

Thassos Dragon Cave, once used to be the capital of the island and is nowadays a lively village, located on the side of a mountain, 15 minutes from Panagia.

It is also known as Drakotrypa, which translates to dragon hole. The cave is full of impressive stalactites and stalagmites and amazing underground caves.

Fun fact: The cave was named after a stalactite that had the shape of a dragon.






LAKE MARIES

Lake Maries is the only artificial lake in Thassos, surrounded by 12 waterfalls in total, below and above the lake. They are accessible to the visitors, although it takes a little hiking to climb up to them and of course take a swim in the cold and clear water.

Fun fact: The lake is almost dry from July to the end of the season.


Caution: If you decide to visit this lake, please have in mind that the road from the village of Maries to the lake is a dirt road.


BEEKEEPERS' COLLECTIVE FACTORY

In 1973, in the island of Thassos a handful of beekeepers founded the Cooperative of Prinos, with a goal of promoting their local products.

Today, the Association consists of 104 beekeepers, who use traditional practices to create healthy products with ecologic packaging, such as: Chestnut honey, Forest honey, Honeycomb, Beeswax, Propolis, Royal jelly and Pollen.


The secluded and not-easy to find rock formation of Giola, may remind you of a private swimming pool but is completely natural, with crystal clear waters, while the height reaches up to 8m. A perfect place for those that love to hike, since it is downhill on a cliff for a few kilometers and does not offer neither shadow around the swimming area nor a beach bar or sunbeds.

Giola has become one of the most popular tourist attractions on Thassos and can get crowded during the high season, July and August.

Tip: If you want to avoid crowds, it is a good idea to get there early in the morning.




THASSOS ANCIENT AGORA

The political, administrative and religious center of the ancient town of Thassos.

Located in a walking distance from the center of Limenas, this is the most important archaeological site on the island.

Although the construction of agora started more systematically on the 4^{th} century BC, the earliest constructions on the site date from the 6^{th} century BC.
